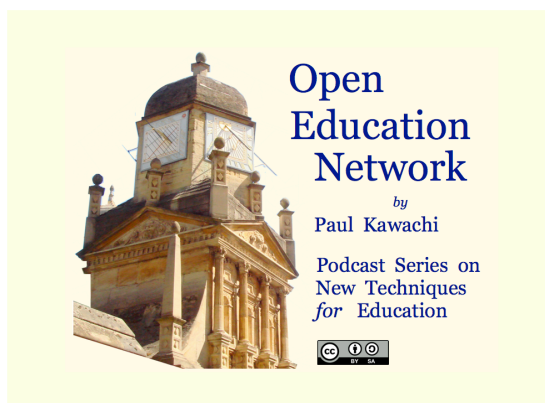
LESSONS, TEACHING PHILOSOPHY, AND TEACHING ASSESSMENTS :
